

Building Interfaces

Where it is possible for people to come into contact with the outer edge of a handrail at a landing and can be drawn into a hazardous situation, such as toppling over a balustrade, appropriate preventative measures shall be taken.

Some examples are:

- prevention of entry into the space by the placement of permanent barriers;
- increasing the height of the building structure of the fixed balustrade in the hazard area by at least 100 mm above the handrail level and positioned between 80 mm and 100 mm from the outer edge of the handrail.
